DIRECTIONS

•From LA and other points northwest, take I-5 south to 805 south. Exit Clairemont Mesa Blvd. East, continue east to Kearny Mesa Road (about 3 miles). Turn left at the signal light, and left into the driveway next to the Hampton Inn at the Al Bahr sign. The Shrine Center is directly behind the Hampton Inn.

•From Riverside and other points northeast, take I-5 south to 163 south. Exit Clairemont Mesa Blvd. West, and turn right at the first signal light onto Kearny Mesa Road. Turn left into the driveway next to the Hampton Inn at the Al Bahr sign. The Shrine Center is directly behind the Hampton Inn.
